

Public Hearing Notice Regarding Proposed Owen County Public Transit FY23/24 Title VI Program

Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act prohibits discrimination based on race, color, or national origin in programs and activities that receive federal financial assistance. Every three years, Owen County Public Transit (OCPT) gathers feedback from the public on how our services and potential changes to service may impact riders. Feedback is then analyzed and will be used to update the proposed FY23/24 Title VI Program.

The public comment period will open on Friday, January 12th and will close on Friday, January 26th, 2024, with an in-person meeting beginning at 3:00 p.m. EST at the Owen County Courthouse located at 100 North Thomas Street, Community Room, Second Floor, Owenton, Kentucky 40359.
